

### Skiing and Snowboarding with Panoramic Views

The Furano Ski Resort was introduced to the world during the 1977 FIS World Cup. Since then, Furano has hosted a total of 10 World Cup races, featuring the world's top skiers. In addition, Furano has hosted the Snowboard World Cup, along with the National Athletic Meet and All Japan Championships multiple times. There are a wide variety of runs available that will suit everyone from beginners to experts.

The Furano Ski Resort is divided into two areas, the "Furano Zone" featuring long runs, and the "Kitanomine Zone" with a wide variety of terrain.

### A Safe and Comfortable Experience



In addition, thermal underwear, helmets, goggles, and warm gloves are essential items.

- Location: Asobiya (near Furano)






# Dogsledding

Experience the thrill of piloting a dog sled through a snowy forest! Drive the Huskies yourself around a 250m path and feel like an Arctic explorer. The activity can be adjusted according to the number of participants and the available time.






- Capacity: 1 person ~ (A large number of people can be accommodated. Consultation required)
- Availability: December 10th to March 20th (depending on the amount of snow and the weather)
- Operation time: 8: 30-15: 00 (last entry)
- Location: Yuma







Ice fishing can only be done in very cold regions. A hole is chopped in the ice in the middle of the frozen lake, and drop your line through the hole. Fish for the Japanese Smelt (or Wakasagi), which is then prepared into very fresh tempura or fried on the spot for you to eat.







- Capacity: 10 100 people
- Ice Fishing season: Late December to early March (\* Depending on ice conditions)
- Time required: 1.5 to 2 hours
- Location: Lake Kanayama (Minami Furano Town)











Hot air balloon free flights are winter-only activities. No ropes! See the Furano Basin and the Tokachidake mountain range from 100 to 1,000 meters above the ground. It's a superb view and the memory of a lifetime. \* Please note that the balloon flights may be canceled due to bad weather.





- Capacity: 2 to 30 people (consultation required)
- Flight time: 20 to 30 minutes
- Dates available: Early December to late March
- Location: Furano Basin













Walk on the snow in a winter wonderland! Your hike will be with a guide, so even beginners can go at their own pace and not worry about a thing.





- Capacity: 10-40 people (negotiable)
- Time required: 2 hours
- Snowshoeing season: Early December to late March (depending on the amount of snow and the weather)
- Location: In the foothills around Furano













# Snowball Fight

Nothing more traditional than a good 'ol snowball fight! Use teamwork and strategy to capture the opponent's flag. International Rules are usually used, but can be changed to local rules depending on the number of people and available time.

# **Snow Sculpture Contest**

Create a unique snow sculpture together with your team! From the prepared 180cm high x 90cm wide pillar, scrape snow away to reveal your work, or add parts as desired. Definitely an activity unique to Snow Country where ideas, senses, and techniques are tested.

- Capacity: 10 120 people
- Availability: Early December to late March (depending on snow conditions)
- Time required: 2 2.5 hours
- Location: Special venue at the Asobiya site.







# Touch Art, Enjoy Art

### Miyama Toge Art Park

A tourism and art facility located on Miyama Pass. From the outdoor observation deck, you can overlook the magnificent Daisetsuzan National Park, and see the active Tokachidake volcano.

### ■ Trick Art Museum

More than 80 "Trick Art" paintings utilize optical illusions for the fun of the viewers. When you take a picture with a painting, it looks like you've entered into the painting itself. A fun museum full of great photo opportunities.



### ■ Glass Etching

Experience for yourself the art of etching on glass, practiced in Europe for hundreds of years. Create original works with your favorite patterns on glasses, platters, and frames.

(Time required 10-60 minutes)





### Goto Sumio Art Museum

A museum that holds and exhibits works covering the career of Sumio Goto, a noted painter in the Japanese art world. A number of masterpieces depicting the four seasons of Japan are on display, including the 14m blockbuster "Unkai Kouzan Usei." On the 2nd floor, the Furano Grill restaurant



overlooks the Tokachidake mountain range, and features a menu with many local ingredients.



The cherry blossoms bloom around the end of April every year. The cherry blossoms in full bloom against the backdrop of the snow-covered mountains are a spectacular view unique to a snowy region. The Hanabito Kaido is also colored in June, and the early lavender is in full bloom in late June. Enjoy the colorful flower fields until the end of September. The first snowfall occurs in late October and the snowfall begins in earnest in December, celebrating the full-scale winter resort season.



Many vegetables are grown with minimal pesticides because of the cold winter. The rich soil and the temperature difference between day and night make melons and watermelons sweet and juicy. Enjoy buying directly from the roadside stands.

# Furano / Biei Area Specialties and Local Food

### The Furano / Biei area is full of popular sweets.

Some of these nationally famous shops may have significant waiting lines during the tourist season. These cafes and restaurants feature original desserts, often with fresh melons, and are directly managed by local farmers.



### **Sweet and Juicy Melons and Watermelons**

Due to the large temperature difference between day and night, Furano melons and watermelons are juicy and have a very high sugar content. Many farmers have direct sales stores along National Routes 237 and 38. which has the nickname "Melon Road."





### Delicious Wild Plants in Shimukappu Village

Surrounded by vast forests, Shimukappu Village harvests various types of wild plants and sells them at roadside stations and supermarkets. In addition, the annual "Sansai Contest" gives awards for the best original edible wild plant recipes, and draws many fans of wild food.



# Hokkaido ingredients go great with curry! They are a popular addition to local curry dishes.



### Furano Omu Curry

A local dish combining curry and omelet rice. Most of the ingredients such as rice, vegetables, meat and eggs are from Furano. In addition, Furano cheese or wine is used, and Furano Milk is usually served with the set.

### Minamifurano Fried Deer Curry

Ezo-style deer cutlet curry that combines fried sika deer meat and curry. The vegetables are from Minamifurano, and rice is from Hokkaido. "Kumasasa tea" known as healthy tea is included in the set.



### Biei Curry Udon

Udon noodles made from Biei wheat, along with Biei pork shabu-shabu and seasonal local vegetables. The oven-baked Biei Curry Udon <Yakimen> and the winter-only <Kakemen> are also popular.

### Yakiniku Menu Unique to a Pig-Farming Town

### Kamifurano Pork [Pork Sagari]

In Kamifurano-cho, a pig-farming town, the standard menu for yakiniku is "pork sagari." It is a low-calorie and healthy part of the diaphragm that weighs only 250-300g from each pig. It is also available as a souvenir from a local butcher shop.



# Made with fresh, rich raw milk Furano cheese is excellent!


Natural cheese produced from fresh milk collected from local dairy farms is a specialty of Furano. At Furano Cheese Factory, you can observe the cheese manufacturing process, and enjoy a tasting corner and an exhibition that introduces the history of cheese.



# At the Furano Winery, sample some wine and observe the manufacturing process.

Due to the suitable climate for grape cultivation, the Furano Vineyard Research Institute was established in 1972, and now "Furano Wine" has grown into a brand that has won awards in various national competitions. There is also a "Grape Juice Factory" located nearby, where you can enjoy fresh grape juice produced from local grapes.

Enjoy a night tour and see the sky full of stars on a clear night – something that has become difficult to see in urban areas. On cloudy nights, we adjust the activity according to the weather and your wishes, such as a night walk, or walking to a viewpoint to see the night view of the city.

# Potato Harvesting & Baked Potato Feast

In the neighboring town of Nakafurano, experience harvesting potatoes by hand, which are local specialties. Learn the tips for harvesting carefully and quickly so as not to damage the surface, and experience farming for about 30 - 60 minutes. Then, using the potatoes you harvested, have a fresh baked potato with Hokkaido butter on top, known as Jaga Butter (literally Potato Butter). In addition, each participant gets 2kg of potatoes for souvenirs.

Blindfolded and barefoot, walk on various paths such as lawn, gravel, fallen leaves, and logs, and feel the earth with a sense other than sight. (Time required 30 minutes)



# Furano Shizenjuku (presided over by writer Soh Kuramoto)

# Learn about the global environment through the senses. This is a non-profit environmental education facility.

An environmental education program run by Soh Kuramoto, the author of the "Kita no Kuni Kara" television show, who lives in Furano. With the closure of the Furano Prince Hotel Golf Course, the school was opened in 2006 using approximately 35 hectares, or 6 holes of the course. While returning the field to the forest, you can recognize the seriousness of environmental problems by experiencing a workshop that revives the "five senses" by using the environmental education equipment nature has already provided us. This is a program that allows instructors to dramatically express themselves using the techniques cultivated in theater, to stimulate the imagination of participants, and to learn about environmental issues while experiencing them.

# Be Aware of the SDGs Lecture on nature and global environment in Hokkaido

Learning the greatness of nature also creates "learning" in skiing and rafting experiences. Please use it as a night program at your accommodation or as a backup in stormy weather. (Time required 60-90 minutes)


# Fossil Excavation Experience

In the Late Cretaceous period (65-99 million years ago), the earth was warm and the sea level was high, and most of the mountainous areas of Hokkaido were under water. Therefore, ammonites and fossil plants can be seen in mountainous rocks. You will experience fossil excavation in the Yubari Mountains, a site famous for collecting many fossils.

# Walking

Walking in the forest on the outskirts of Furano, passing through areas with conifers, broad-leaved trees, and wild flowers. There are various trail options depending on the operating company, such as "Blue Pond / Shirogane Nature Walk" and "Ansei Crater Hiking", which involve a drive to Biei and Kamifurano.

# Cycling

# Ropeway

The Furano Ski Resort ropeway and gondola operate early in the morning during the green season. Ride to an altitude of 900m in about 7 minutes. Beyond the rural landscape of the Furano Basin, you can see the panorama of Daisetsuzan National Park, which stretches from north to south. A combination of different weather conditions can lead to a splendid sea of clouds.

- Time Required: depends on the content

# ~ Morning experience ~ Hot Air Balloon Moored Flight

Enjoy the natural landscape from the sky with a tethered hot air balloon flight. See the vast Furano Basin and the Tokachidake mountain range with its volcanic steam. The hot air balloons are attached with four mooring ropes, so you can safely experience air travel. In winter, experience a true free flight as the balloon flies for 30 minutes down the Furano valley.



- Capacity: 20 to 160 people (negotiable), 4 to 6 people per flight
- Availability: Year-round
- Time Required: Depends on the number of people. Each flight is 3-5 minutes
- Location: Furano

  \*\* Length of flight and office hours vary depending on the season.









After receiving instruction and hints on how to fish, enjoy fishing on the shores of lakes and rivers. You can catch rainbow trout, whitespotted char, and Dolly Varden trout, which is endemic to Hokkaido, depending on the season. You can cook the fish on the spot and enjoy your catch. It is also possible to prepare river fish for tasting in advance.







- Capacity: 10 to 80 people Time required: 1,5 2 hours
- Availability: Late April to early November
- Location: Beberui River (Kamifurano Town), Sorachi River (Furano), Lake Takisato (Ashibetsu)

% Depending on the operating company, it is also possible to prepare local vegetables and meat in addition to the fish and have a barbecue.













# Kayaking

A canoeing experience on Lake Kanayama, the headwaters of the Sorachi River. After arriving at the lake, receive some brief instruction before boarding in pairs. Although it is an artificial lake created with the construction of the Kanayama Dam, it is a lake with a beautiful landscape surrounded by forests and is also known as a habitat for the phantom fish "Ito".



- Capacity: 10-40 people
- Time required: 1 hour
- Availability: Late April-October
- Location: Lake Kanayama (Minamifurano Town)





### Inflatable Kayak (Ducky Packraft)

Experience going down a gentle river on a rubber boat type cance. Paddle with one or two people and row in the wilderness with your own power. The guide will be in another boat. It is a program that even beginners can participate with peace of mind.





- Capacity: 10-40 people Time required: 2.0 2.5 hours \*\* Length may vary depending on the number of participants and river conditions.
- Availability: Late April to early November
- Location: Sorachi River (Furano)

















### Most popular activity!

In early spring, choose the plan that suits your time and taste, such as running the river at high volume due to melting snow (Ochiai), or the leisurely section (Shimo-Kanayama). You can also swim in the river from a boat in the calm sections. The number of participants can be up to 200 people at one time. Each boat is steered by a trained guide.
